CONDITIONS

1. This Pass is an Official Document issued and held subject to the provisions of Section 1 of the Official Secrets Act, 1920, and of the Defence Regulations. Its unauthorized use, retention, alteration, destruction, or transfer to another person are penal offences.
2. This Pass will permit the Bearer when on duty to enter a Prohibited Place within the meaning of the Official Secrets Acts, or a Protected Place or Area within the meaning of the Defence Regulations; but not until he has satisfied the Officer or Official in Charge that his admission is necessary in the course of his official duty on His Majesty's Service.
3. This Pass must be presented for inspection on the demand of a person on duty who is a member of His Majesty's Forces, a Policeman, or an Employee of the Official in Charge of a Prohibited or Protected Place or Area, duly authorized for this purpose.
4. This Pass must be returned to the Issuing Office on demand and without demand in the event of the Bearer ceasing to hold any appointment or occupation on account of which this Pass was issued.
5. The Bearer should carry this Pass in an addressed envelope to facilitate its restoration if mislaid, and should make a separate note of the Number of the Pass.
6. The loss or finding of this Pass should be reported at once to the Issuing Office or to the Police.
